TEMA	DESARROLLO
1	Parts of an Airplane. Vocabulary: Parts of an aeroplane such as control surfaces, pedals, control column, knobs, instrument, engines, systems, galleys, cargo compartment, fuel tanks, communication and navigation equipments, ILS landing system, etc.
2	Flying Maneuvers Vocabulary: pre flight check list, before take off, take off, climb, cruise, level flying, descend, approach, landing, turns, stall, cross wind landings, angle of attack, spins, straight level, rotation, trim about. A Commercial aircraft cockpit and cabin.
3	Vocabulary: main part, aft, outlet, switch, adjustable, duct, pressurized, air conditioning, tray, jump seat, safety belt, passenger service unit, blow, service panel, oven, lights control, passenger address system, trolley, slide, exit, raft, emergency equipment, smoke detector, panels. Passenger Travel
4	Vocabulary: check in point, overweight, airport, charge, no show, waiting led, eventually, delay, stand by, ticket, luggage, departure, arrival, E.T.D., E.T.A. A typical operation of a B-737 (or Company's usually operated airplane).
5	All the vocabulary involved in such a description should be used.
6	In the hangar Vocabulary: drill, rivets, ribs, stringers, skin, inspection plates, fillets, joints, longerons, check, overhaul, inspection checks.
7	Aviation Weather forecasting. Vocabulary: dense, synoptic chart, prognostic chart, overall, fronts, freezing levels, depression, velocity, clouds, high pressure system Low pressure system, head winds.
