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## past simple irregular verbs

| Infinitive | Past + | Past -       |
|------------|--------|--------------|
| go         | went   | didn't go    |
| have       | had    | didn't have  |
| get        | got    | didn't get   |
| buy        | bought | didn't buy   |
| leave      | left   | didn't leave |
| drive      | drove  | didn't drive |
| meet       | met    | didn't meet  |
| see        | saw    | didn't see   |
| wear       | wore   | didn't wear  |
| do         | did    | didn't do    |

- Use the irregular past form only in **+** sentences.  
*I saw a film last night.*
- Use the infinitive after *did / didn't*.  
*Did you see a film last night?* NOT *Did you saw...?*
- Remember word order = **ASI** (auxiliary, subject, infinitive) or **QUASI** (question word, auxiliary, subject, infinitive).  
*Did you go out last night?*  
*Where did you go?*



Past of *can* = *could*.

**-** = *couldn't* NOT *didn't can*

**?** = *Could you...?* NOT *Did you can...?*
