

Aviation English Course

Aviation English is the internationally established language of the skies, consisting of about three hundred terms that are a combination of professional jargon and plain English.

With the expansion of air travel during the 20th century, concerns about the ability of pilots and air traffic controllers to communicate effectively across cultures and languages arose. In 1951, the International Civil Aviation Organization recommended that English be accepted as the lingua franca of the sky, and within a few years, Aviation English exams had become a requirement for all pilots involved in international flight, including native English speakers.

Not only pilots and air traffic controllers should speak English. Whether you are a member of the cabin crew, aircraft dispatcher, involved in check in or part of maintenance team, it is essential to have a good command of the English language.
